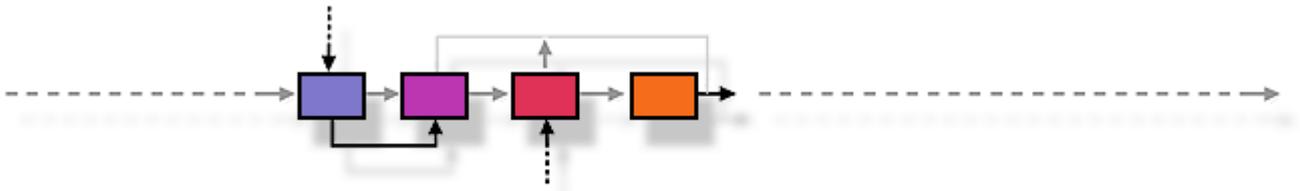

Background: the EC merge and the elections



- After the October 2012 elections we will merge the two ECs and eliminate Oracle's and IBM's duplicate seats, resulting in a single EC with 30 members.
- JCP 2.8 gives us the option, in anticipation of the Merge, not to fill ratified seats that become vacant before the 2013 election.
- During the 2012 elections all seats will be labeled generically as *EC seats* rather than as *ME or SE/EE seats*.
- During the 2013 elections we will eliminate three ratified and two elected seats, reducing the size of the EC to 25.
 - All sitting members will be required to run for re-election.

Ratified seats



- Six “ex-ME” ratified seats are available: those held by Samsung, SK Telecom, AT&T, Siemens, T-Mobile, and Vodafone.
- Three “ex-SE/EE” ratified seats are available: those held by Credit Suisse, Fujitsu, and HP (IBM’s SE/EE seat is being eliminated.)
- Nominations for “merged” ratified seats:
 - Cinterion, Credit Suisse, Fujitsu, and HP.
- Five seats will be held in reserve for 2013.
 - Three of them will be eliminated then.

Elected seats



- Two elected seats will be contested in 2012: the seat currently held by the London Java Community and the seat previously held by CableLabs.
- Candidates: Cisco, CloudBees, Giuseppe Dell'Abate, Liferay, London Java Community, Morocco JUG, North Sixty-One, Software AG, Zero Turnaround.

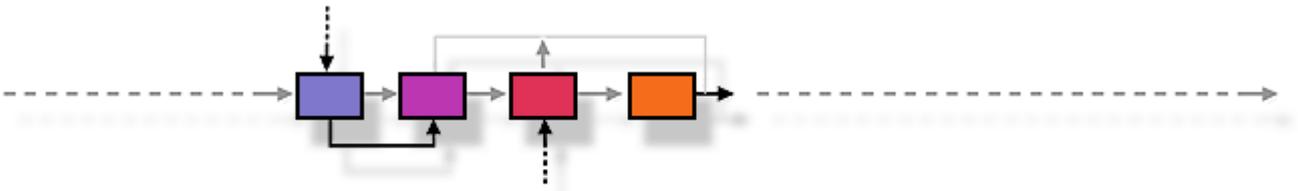
Schedule and nominee information

- Ballot: October 16 – 29.
- *Meet the Candidates* conference call: October 18.
- Results announced: October 30.
- JCP “quiet period” (no ballots): October 30 – November 12.
- New members take office: November 13.
- First meeting of the merged EC: November 20.
