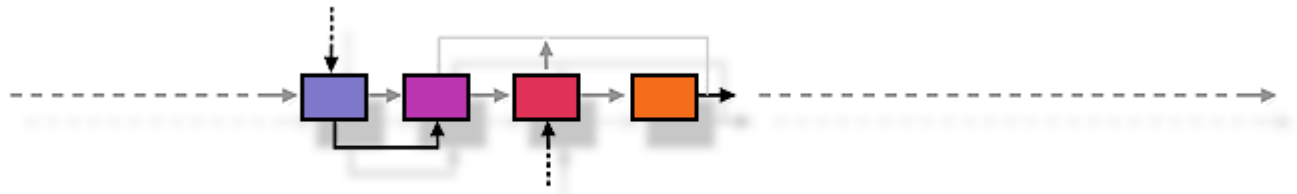

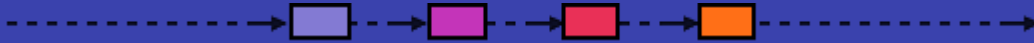

# EC meeting attendance



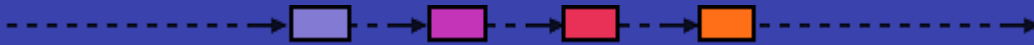
- EC members who miss two meetings in a row lose their voting privileges until they have attended two in a row.

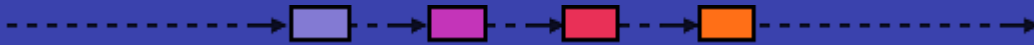

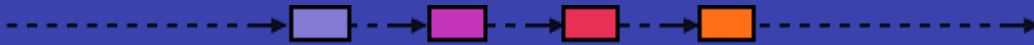

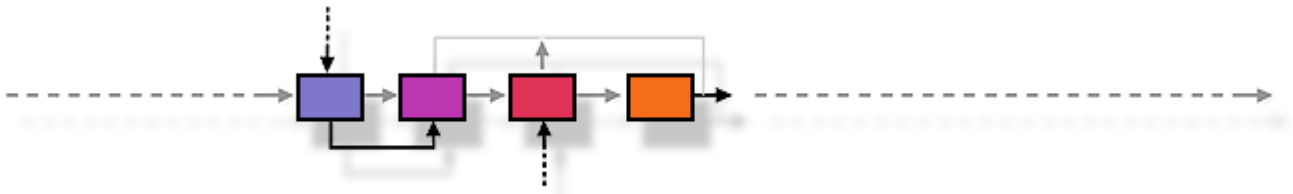
