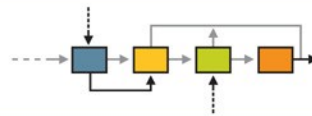

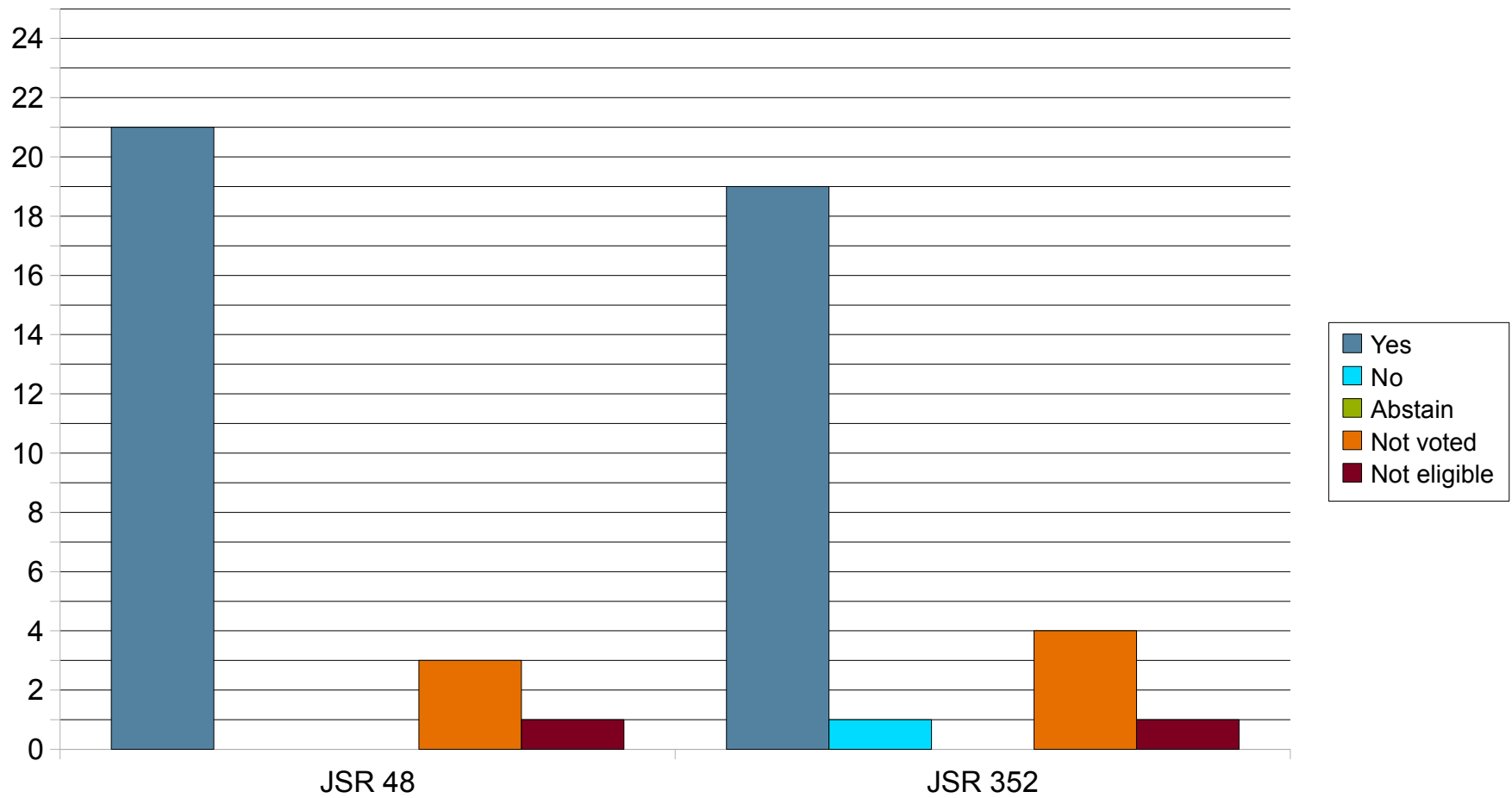
- **JSR 48: Final Approval Reconsideration Ballot – WBEM Services Specification; WBEM Solutions (ballot 10-23 June)**
