JSR Updates

- JSR 398: Public Review Final Approval Ballot/Final Release — Java SE 23; Oracle (EC Ballot 20-26 August)
- JSR 399: JSR Iteration — Java SE 24; Oracle
- JSR 199: Maintenance Release — Java Compiler API; Oracle

JSR Ballots

- JSR 398; Java SE 23; Public Review Final Approval Ballot approved
- 18 yes votes: Alibaba, [amazon.com](https://www.amazon.com) web services, ARM, Azul Systems, BNY Mellon, Bellsoft, Eclipse Foundation, Ken Fogel, Fujitsu, IBM, Intel, JetBrains, MicroDoc, Microsoft, Oracle, SAP, SouJava, Miro Wengner

Notes on JSRs

- The Final Release of JSR 398 (Java SE 23) was on Tuesday 10 September. Thank you to the EC for voting to approve the platform JSR and the MRs for the component JSRs: 199 (Java Compiler API) and 269 (Pluggable Annotation-Processing API).
- On Tuesday 15 October, Oracle shipped the first production releases which include the updated specification from the July MRs for JSR 337 (Java SE 8), JSR 384 (SE 11), and JSR 392 (SE 17). OpenJDK releases are expected soon.
- JSR 399 (Java SE 24) is currently in progress. Two JEPs have been targeted to JDK 24, so far with more expected within the next 4 - 6 weeks before feature freeze on Thursday 5 December. PR is expected to begin in January.
- OpenJDK October Security releases 8u432, 11.0.25, 17.0.13 [GA 1-2 weeks later than ORCL release]
- Oracle October CPU releases 8u431, 11.0.25, 17.0.13) [GA 2024-10-15 7:00AM PT]
