- PMO votes on nomination

- Spec Lead posts nomination information (JCP 2.8)
- Spec Lead votes on nomination

# Composition of an Expert Group



- Expert Group should have sufficiently diverse experts to represent the community interested in the JSR space
- Expert Group public listing on jcp.org shows official Expert Group (http://jcp.org/en/jsr/detail?id=xxx)
- Expert Group private listing on jcp.org shows EG contact information (http://jcp.org/en/eg/view?id=xxx)
- If a person isn't listed there, then that person isn't officially on the Expert Group
- Expert Group is not automatically populated with the 'Initial Expert Group' from the JSR proposal
- Everyone on the Expert Group is added the same way

### The nomination



- Nominee must have an account on jcp.org
- Nomination can happen before nominee is able to legally participate on the EG
- Nominee fills out the form at http://jcp.org/en/jsr/egnom
- E-mail is sent to Spec Lead(s)
- Nomination is ready for votes from PMO, Spec Lead(s)
- Nominee can check status of his nomination on jcp.org, under 'My JSRs'

If you are an individual Member, you will also need to provide an Exhibit B signed by your employer.

#### PMO votes



- PMO determines whether nominee can legally participate on that particular Expert Group
- Nominee must represent an active JCP Member
- JCP Member must have appropriate JSPA in place
- Nominee must not be from embargoed or terrorist country
- Expert Group must be open to new nominations
- Individual Members must have an Exhibit B on file for the JSR
- PMO contacts nominee if any of these conditions are not met, explains what (if anything) can be done to remove block
- PMO votes: Y, X, XJ, XB, P, I
- Nominee can also see PMO vote under 'My JSRs'
- PMO updates vote when conditions change

## **Specification Lead votes**



- Spec Lead receives nominations in e-mail
- Spec Lead can review and vote on nominations on the JSR's Administration tab (http://jcp.org/en/eg/noms?id=xxx)
- Spec Lead considers only whether nominee is desirable for Expert Group (discusses with existing EG)
- Spec Lead casts vote: Y, N, P
- Spec Lead should select P to indicate that the nomination has been seen and is being considered
- Nominee can see Spec Lead vote under 'My JSRs'
- Spec Lead(s) will get daily e-mail reminders if a nomination sits for a week without a vote

## 2.8 Requirement: EG nominations



- JCP 2.8 JSRs are required to provide the details of all Expert Group nominations via the public communications channel.
- Names of all nominees
- Substantive deliberations/discussion of nominees
- Decision on each nominee (Y or N)
- Reason for decision (if not already provided in deliberations)

# Updating an Expert Group



- Spec Lead(s) can request to close an Expert Group (admin@jcp.org), or open it again later
- Closing an Expert Group removes the 'I would like to join this Expert Group' link, and the PMO will notify any new nominees that EG is closed...unless the Spec Lead asks for an explicit exception
- > Spec Lead(s) can remove an expert (admin@jcp.org)
- Any replacements or additions to an Expert Group must go through the same process described earlier
- Experts should use 'My Profile' to update their own contact information
- Such profile edits change the account for the whole site, not just for one JSR

### Further notes



- Nominees are automatically added to an Expert Group when both PMO and Spec Lead votes are 'Y'
- Expert Group officially disbands at Final Release
- The PMO will not make changes to the Expert Group listing after Final Release
- By default, site displays only the last 60 days of nominations
- To view and vote on older nominations, add '?days=###' to the nomination page URL
- If an expert leaves one employer and wants to participate representing a new employer, the expert must start from the beginning (create an account, submit nomination, etc.)
